Detailed Regulations for Preliminary Review Procedures, etc. for Granting Degree for Doctoral Dissertation in Graduate School of Global Studies of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies

(June 27, 2012
Regulation No. 117)

Article 1 Purpose

These Detailed Regulations provide for the procedures for the preliminary review or other matters necessary for granting degrees for doctoral dissertations (hereinafter referred to as the "Preliminary Review") in accordance with the provisions of Article 5, paragraph 2 of the Regulations Concerning Academic Degrees of National University Corporation Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (established on January 19, 1993; hereinafter referred to as the "Degree Regulations").

Article 2 Preliminary Review

The preliminary review shall be intended for matters prescribed in Article 7, paragraph 4 of the Degree Regulations.

Article 3 Procedures for Application for Preliminary Review, etc.

1 Any person who intends to undergo a preliminary review (hereinafter referred to as the "Preliminary Review Applicant") shall apply for the preliminary review, together with the following documents, to the Chairperson of the Council of the Graduate School of Global Studies through a faculty who is appropriate for the subject matter, etc. of the doctoral dissertation (hereinafter referred to as the "Introductory Faculty").

- (1) Application for Doctoral Dissertation Preliminary Review (Appended Form 1) 1 copy
- (2) Dissertation to be submitted at the time of application for grant of degree 1 copy
- (3) Summary of the doctoral dissertation indicated above in Japanese and in English 1 copy each
- (4) Curriculum vitae 1 copy
- (5) Research achievement sheet 1 copy

2 The Introductory Faculty shall be a professor or associate professor in charge of the Doctoral Program.

Article 4 Preliminary Review Member

Upon receipt of the application, the Chairperson of the Council shall immediately appoint preliminary review members to conduct the preliminary review and also report the same to the Council.

Article 5 Report of Preliminary Review Results

- 1 Preliminary review members shall promptly review the submitted documents and report the review results to the Chairperson of the Council using the doctoral dissertation preliminary review report.
- 2 The Chairperson of the Council shall consult with the Council whether or not the applicant of the preliminary review may apply for the award of the degree based on the report provided by the preliminary review members and shall notify the result of deliberation to the applicant.

Article 6 Miscellaneous Provisions

Any matters not set forth in these Detailed Regulations concerning the procedures for preliminary review shall be prescribed by the Chairperson of the Council separately.
